



Q2 How clearly did the SQL PLSQL instructor explain difficult material?



Q3 How well did the SQL PLSQL instructor relate course topics to each other?



Q4 Which is the most satisfying part of the SQL PLSQL training course ?



Q5 Which is the best explained topic in the training course ?



Q6 How likely are you to recommend DBA University to others?







Q10 Are you considering to use DBA University's services in the future ?



Q11 Would you prefer weekend training or weekday training ?.


